Ok... Everybody, close your eyes, I want you to see this...
This morning, we are for a moment going to walk by faith, not by sight...
Seriously, close your eyes, I really want you to see this.

Today is Pastor Appreciation day here at the Gathering. So first we are going to honor our Main pastors; the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. I know this is good with you. Amen???

So here we go...

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him, nothing was made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men, and the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it...John 1: 1-5

And the word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the Glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of Grace and Truth...John 1:14

And listen to this... And of His fullness we have all received... Grace for Grace... John 1:16

Ok, you may open your eyes...

Grace for Grace... not Grease...grace is not the grease we slide in to heaven on...now listen to me, yes His grace is sufficient, but it is so much more. For If you forgive men their trespasses, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses...Mat 6:14-15

Nope...No He won't...

So if we want to Honor the Father, Son and Holy Spirit...A great place to start is Forgiveness... And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you... Eph 4:32 Good start...Now let's move forward and show honor to the pastors that have been given to us here at The Gathering.

First I want to say, it has been an incredible 7 years watching how God has orchestrated putting together this little tribe and it's leadership, and I am so excited about what He is going to do going forward.

Hold on stay with me...I feel some squirming in the room...

You are cursed with a curse, for you have robbed me, even this whole nation.

Well that didn't help did it, many of us are now looking down at the floor...hang in there...Listen to this... Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house,

And try me now in this. Says the Lord of host, If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.

And if you think that is amazing, listen to what he says next.

And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, So that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field.

Say the Lord of host...Mal 3:8-11

Trusting God, walking by faith, not by sight...That is how you honor John Baugh Let's pray,

Events like Winter crave, tee shirts like Blow Chunks in reference to Revelations teaching about being lukewarm and being Vomited out of God's mouth...

I could see there was a call of God on his life. His passion for the Gospel and his love for God's word was always evident.

When I think of Paul, I often think of James, Jesus's brother who got to hold the pen and write a letter that would change and challenge millions.

So as I conclude today, If you really want to honor Pastor Paul, listen to these words and remember to Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you. Mat 6:33

Read James 1:1-8, 16-17, 19-25

Honor Paul and Wendy by being teachable...follow the scriptures, being obedient...doers of the word.

Remember all of this, is in context of your relationship with Jesus...

So here is the question, actually the questions...

Have you been born again? Jesus says you must be born again.

And if you have been born again, have you been baptized in the Holy Spirit?

To fulfill Jesus's commandments (the great commission) we must have the Holy Spirit as our operating system, no other will do.

If you cannot say yes to both of these questions... Ask and It will be given to you, seek and you will find, knock and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. Or what man is there among you who, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? If you then being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him! Mat 7:7-11

All of our Pastors need us to be teachable, they are our equippers for a time such as now...

## Let's Pray,

Heavenly Father, Lord, by the power of your Holy Spirit, anoint Paul and Wendy to preach and teach and bring Apostolic results (Acts2:37), as our Pastors speak the word, let signs and wonders follow confirming It (Mark 16:20). Let the sick be healed; let the oppressed be set free. Anoint Paul and Wendy with the truth (Mat 16:17). Let people be cut to the heart and receive Jesus and be baptized in The Holy Spirit...
